

## 3/17/2021 Grade 3 & 4 In Class Lesson

1. We are going to go over the 4<sup>th</sup> , 5<sup>th</sup> the 6<sup>th</sup> and the 9<sup>th</sup> Commandment.
2. Fourth Commandment: Honor Your Father and Mother
  - a. Start with page 91. Read the first column. Ask how Jesus would have obeyed Jesus and Mary. What would his life have been like? How can you obey your parents? Find Exodus 20:12 in the Bible.
  - b. Do the Wheel of Happiness pg. 92 together.
  - c. Read pg. 93 Mark 12:13-17 or find it in the Bible and read it. What does this mean? How does this relate to honoring your father and mother? Who else do you have to obey?
3. Fifth Commandment: You Shall Not Kill
  - a. View the photos and ask which ones belong to God? Who created all of them? Make the point that the life of every person belongs to God and all life is precious to Him from the unborn, to the elderly, the dying and even the animals.
  - b. Discuss 4 ways to stay healthy, to take care of the body God gave you.
  - c. Read pg. 99 about Fr. Claver. Ask how you can take care of others?
  - d. On paper do the bottom of pg. 99. What are ways to destroy life?
  - e. Read Luke 10:25-37, the Good Samaritan. We read this before so the students should be familiar with the story. Ask: who would you be in the story, the robbers, the religious man, the traveler or the Samaritan?
4. Sixth Commandment: You Shall Not Commit Adultery  
Ninth Commandment: You Shall Not Covet Your Neighbor's Wife
  - a. Read pg. 103 and discuss what God means by saying our bodies are good. Genesis 1:27
  - b. Read the adaptation of 1 Corinthians 6:14, 15, 18-20 on pg. 104. What does it mean that you are a temple of the Holy Spirit? Relate it back to receiving the Eucharist which is Christ.
  - c. The bottom of pg. 104 are ideas to keep one holy.
  - d. Read pg. 105.
  - e. Read about marriage being a special friendship on pg. 106. Use the word "**Covenant**" as the special bond. Remind students that a covenant is the special promise God made to Noah and to Moses and the Israelites. He makes this promise to make two people one with Him in Holy Matrimony.
